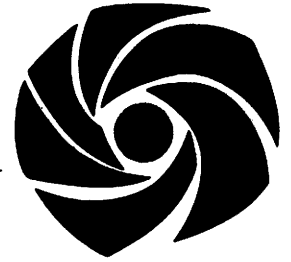

LEGISLATIVE NEWS ABOUT HAM CALL LETTER LICENCE PLATES: Senate Bill SB-1135, introduced 1-17-84 by Senator Lunn; Representatives Hawke, English before the Arizona legislature, proposes to reduce from \$25.00 to \$10.00 the additional charge per set of original Amateur Radio Call Letter licence plates. The Bill also seeks to eliminate the present \$10.00 additional charge for annual renewal of Amateur Call Letter licence plates. Do express your enthusiastic support for passage of Senate Bill SB-1135 by writing and calling Senator Lunnor and Rep's. Hawk and English.
